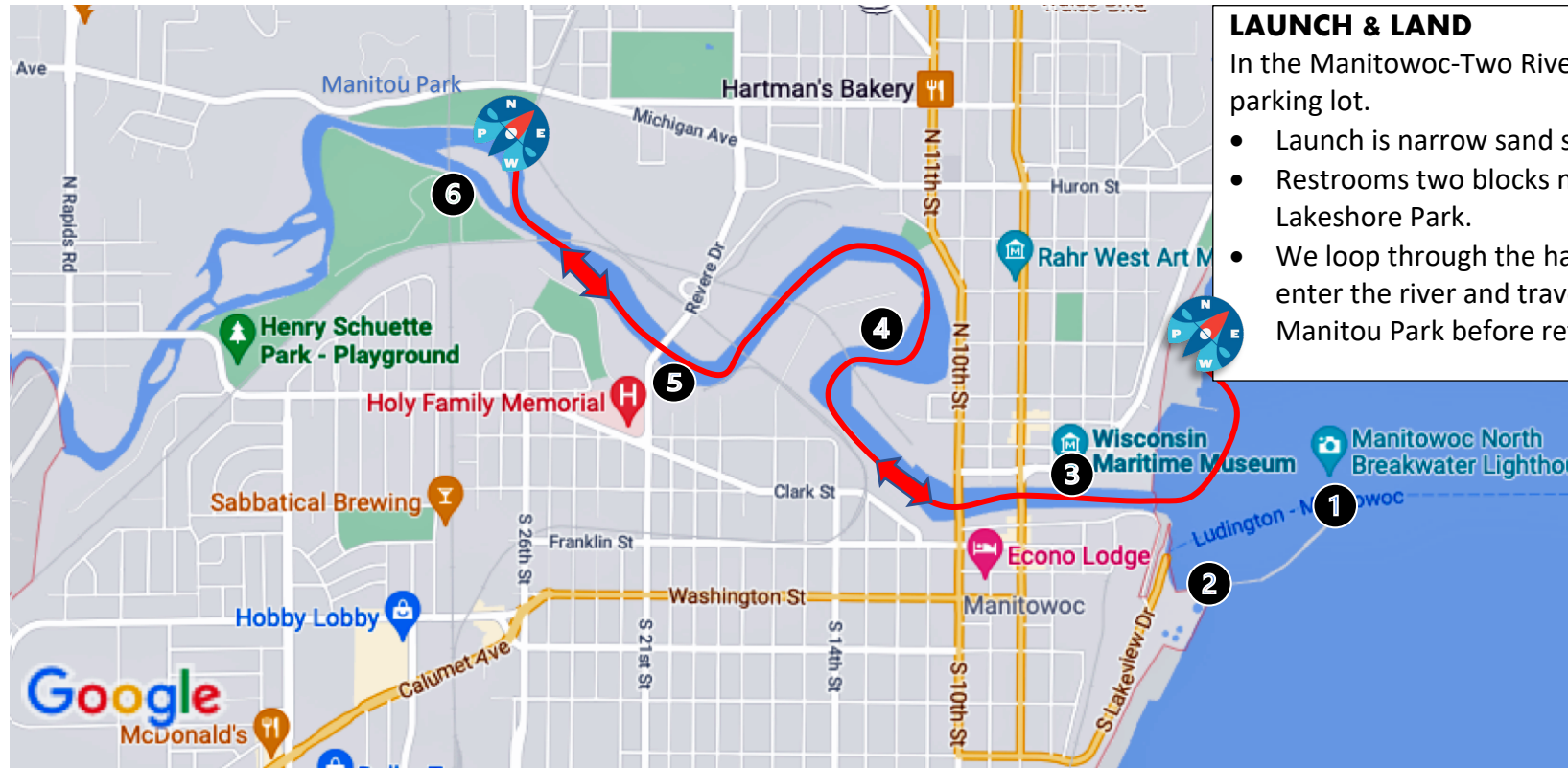




Manitowoc River Paddle



LAUNCH & LAND

In the Manitowoc-Two Rivers YMCA parking lot.

- Launch is narrow sand shoreline.
- Restrooms two blocks north in Lakeshore Park.
- We loop through the harbor, enter the river and travel to Manitou Park before returning.

HIGHLIGHTS

This 6-mile out-and-back paddle starts from behind the Manitowoc-Two Rivers YMCA. We loop through the harbor, enter the river and travel to Manitou Park for pack-your-own lunch before returning. Paddle may be extended to Schuette Park.

1. **Manitowoc Breakwater Light** – Built in 1918 and automated in 1971, the 52-foot lighthouse is not open for tours.
2. **S.S. Badger Carferry Dock**
3. **USS Cobra & Wisconsin Maritime Museum** – Submarine tours offered.
4. **Broadwind Towers Inc.** – Manufacturer of wind turbine towers and large naval cranes.
5. **Burger Boat Co.** – Builder of hand-built pleasure boats since 1863.
6. **Manitowoc High-Trestle Bridge** – Operational 80-foot-high bridge built by C&N Railroad in 1906
